- Collar with ID Tag

- Waste bags & Holder
- Seat belt/harness for car rides
- Safe Chew Toys

Nutrition

- Food
- Food & Water Bowls
- Training treats

Grooming

- Puppy Shampoo
- Ear Cleaner
- Nail Clippers
- Slicker Brush and/or Comb
- Drying Towels

Services

- Set Vet Appointment within 72 hours of Puppy Pickup
- Locate nearest 24 Hour Emergency Animal Hospital
- Determine Puppy Training Plan and arrange training classes
- Find Groomer if needed

Cleaning Products

- Enzymatic Cleaner
- Odor Neutralizer
- Puppy Waste Bags and/or Scooper
- Cleaning Towels

Dangerous For Puppies
